# RECYCLING PROGRAM FAQ

## What do I do when it's time to recycle the phone directories?

Once you've received your Windstream Yellow Pages 2009 directory, beginning Jan. 5, 2009 through Feb. 7, 2009, bring your duplicates or old directories to the approved collection points.

You can also recycle your directories through the local Boy Scouts of America. Local troops will be collecting directories to fulfill requirements toward earning the World Conservation Award. Furthermore, special collection drives will be held at the Belmont and Irving Recreation Centers on Jan. 31 and Feb. 7, 2009. These events will feature special prizes.

## Can I only recycle Windstream Yellow Pages directories?

Windstream Yellow Pages is proud to sponsor the only phone directory recycling program in Lincoln. Not only will we recycle outdated Windstream Yellow Pages directories, but we're happy to accept outdated and new directories from other manufacturers.

## Can I bring other materials to the collection point?

While we encourage you to recycle all possible materials, for this program we can only accept directories. Please recycle other materials in accordance with your local recycling services.

## Can I take my directories to a location other than one at a Lincoln Parks and Recreation location or place them in my recycling bin at home?

Not every recycler accepts every type of paper. Windstream Yellow Pages and the Lincoln Parks and Recreation Department have partnered with a specialty recycler, Recycling Enterprises of Nebraska, Inc., so it is important to bring your directories to the identified collection point or a local boy scout to ensure it's recycled properly.
